The volume also provides the text of each Federal Rule of Evidence, along with summary discussions, legislative history notes, and bibliographic references, updated in this release with the most recent scholarship.

Reflected in this release is the **recent amendment to Rule 807**, the so-called “residual exception.” The rule was completely rewritten, effective December 1, 2019, after a multi-year study of problems that have emerged in caselaw over the recent decades. The text of the amended text is set out, along with a detailed summary written by the author on the rule’s requirements, and legislative history notes. **Volume 1, Article 8, Rule 807.**

Volume 2, the Case Authority, includes **thousands of case summaries** of decisions under the Federal Rules of Evidence from all jurisdictions, updated in this release with the **most recent district and circuit court decisions from the past year.**
