Release #45 of *New York Elder Law* updates Chapter 6, **Medicaid for the Elderly, Blind, or Disabled**, and corresponding appendices.

- **Coronavirus (COVID-19) Temporary Modifications to the Eligibility Process.** The normal application procedures to apply for and maintain Medicaid eligibility have been temporarily modified due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The temporary modifications to the Medicaid eligibility process are covered in new section 6:12.1.
- **New Lookback and Transfer Penalties for Home Care Service.** In an effort to reduce the New York State Budget, changes are being made to the state's Medicaid Program, specifically the Medicaid home care application process. New section 6:12.2 provides a current summary of what is presently known about the new Lookback and Transfer Penalties rules for community-based long-term care services. At the time of this writing, the New York State Medicaid Program has not published the details on how these new changes will be implemented.
